



Methodology

In this report, we've compiled a database of Black, Latino & Women founded companies who have raised \$1M+ in Web3.

Our data comes from Harlem Capital's proprietary database alongside databases from Crunchbase & Pitchbook. This report only includes publicly available information and therefore excludes undisclosed funding rounds.

For the scope of this report, we include U.S. based businesses that have raised \$1M+ within the Blockchain and/or Cryptocurrency industries (Web3).









Key Findings

- 1) White women make up 57% of total companies, but Asian & Latino women have a higher median raised of \$18M & \$26M, respectively.
- 2) There are 17 sub-industries represented, with majority of companies falling within FinTech. The median raised within FinTech is also larger than most other sectors, excluding AR/VR.
- 3) Latino founders have 9 sub-industries represented, the largest being FinTech, while Black founders have 8 subindustries represented, the largest being Big Data & Cloud.
- 4) The largest amount of capital raised by both women and men founders is in the FinTech sector, followed by the software sector.
- 5) There are 20 states represented, with majority of companies being headquartered in CA & NY.
- 6) Majority of companies are still in early stages with 42% having a latest funding round at the Seed stage.
- 7) 2021 and 2018 saw the largest bumps in capital raised for Black, Latino & Women founders in Web3, with 2021 experiencing a 5.2x increase from the year prior.
- 8) 2018 had the most funding rounds for Black, Latino & Women founders in Web3 at 91 total rounds, followed by 2021 at 57 total rounds.














Total Capital Raised






Sub-Industries by Race







Sub-Industries by Gender


The largest amount of capital raised by both women and men founders is in the FinTech sector, followed by the software sector.






Top States by Number of Companies



Top States by Capital Raised (\$M)




Concentration by Number of Companies




Latest Round Stages

Total Capital Raised (\$M)






Total Capital Raised by Year
