Introduction

This is our 2024 Diverse Founder Report, which tracks Black and Latino US based founders that have raised \$1M+ in venture funding per Crunchbase data.

This year the report expanded from 1,257 companies to 1,338 companies. We also now show detailed information on the 42 diverse unicorn companies and founders.






Key Findings

- 1) The 1,338 companies raised \$52.3B of capital with a median raise of \$6.2M
- 2) Women-led companies represent 34% of total companies, but only 21% of capital raised
- 3) Seed rounds represent 37% of total companies, but only 4% of capital raised
- 4) Software, Fintech, and Healthcare represent 33% of companies, but 39% of capital raised
- 5) California and New York represent 55% of companies, but 59% of capital raised
- 6) There have been 42 unicorns with \$24B of total capital raised
- 7) 2024 saw an 14% increase in capital raised, with Series C leading the way









HCP Outlook


For the first time since 2021, we are seeing an increase in capital raised by Black & Latino founders (14% increase YoY). We've added:

- ❖ 81 Black & Latino founded companies to the \$1M+ VC funded list
- \$3.0B incremental capital raised
- 2 new diverse unicorns
- 1 new investor to the list of those who have made 25+ investments into Black & Latino founders

There were 6 raises this year that exceeded \$100M in size, compared to 5 last year. Notably we have seen an uptick in late-stage activity at the Series C.

Harlem Capital is confident that we will continue to see growth in the Black & Latino VC funding market as more companies scale and more diverse investors enter the space.
























Annual Trends By Rounds and Dollars

In 2024, Seed & Series A rounds declined by an average of 22%, Series B rounds declined by 28%, but Series C rounds






Seed & Series A Rounds Represent 15% Of Capital

Series B+ rounds represent 28% of capital raised, the lowest percentage in the last 12 years






Rounds Decreased 37% in 2024

Seed, Series A, & Series B declined in 2024, with the largest percentage decline seen in Series B












CleanTech Raised the Most Capital in 2024






